2 b r 0 2 b is a science fiction short story by Kurt Vonnegut originally published in the digest magazine *Worlds of If* (science fiction) January 1962 and collected in Vonnegut's *Bagombo Snuff Box* 1999. The title is pronounced 2 b r naught 2 b referencing the famous phrase "to be or not to be" from William Shakespeare's *Hamlet*. Prince of Denmark. In this story the title refers to the telephone number one dials to schedule an assisted suicide with the Federal Bureau of Termination. Vonnegut's 1965 novel *God Bless You, Mr. Rosewater* describes a story by this name attributing it to his recurring character Kilgore Trout. Although the plot summary given is closer in nature to the eponymous tale from his short story collection *Welcome to the Monkey House*.
